This policy (together with our terms of use and any other documents referred to on it) sets out the basis on which any personal data we collect from you, or that you provide to us, will be processed by us. Please read the following carefully to understand our approach to use of your personal data.

Information we may collect from you

We may collect and process the following data about you:

- Information that you provide by filling in forms on our site.
- If you contact us (by phone, e-mail or otherwise), we may keep a record of the correspondence.
- Details of your visits to our site including, but not limited to, traffic data, location data and other communication data and the resources that you access. This does not identify any individual.

IP addresses

We may collect information about your computer including, where available, your IP address, operating system and browser type, for system administration purposes. This is statistical data about our users' browsing actions and patterns, and does not identify any individual.

Cookies

A cookie is a small file that holds a certain amount of data, which our website can send to your browser. It may then be stored on your computer's hard drive and can be accessed by our web server. To clarify, cookies do not collect any personal data stored on your hard drive or computer.

Disclosure of your information

We may disclose your personal information to third parties:

- In the event that we sell or buy any business or assets, in which case we may disclose your personal data to the prospective seller or buyer of such business or assets.
- If Arius International Ltd. or substantially all of its assets are acquired by a third party, in which case personal data held by it about its customers will be one of the transferred assets.
- If we are under a duty to disclose or share your personal data in order to comply with any legal obligation, or in order to enforce or apply our terms of use and other agreements; or to protect the rights, property, or safety of Arius International Ltd., our customers, or others. This includes exchanging information with other companies and organisations for the purposes of fraud protection and credit risk reduction.
- We may disclose this information to any other third parties, e.g.:
 - - Business partners, suppliers and sub-contractors for the performance of any contract we enter into with them or you.
 - - Analytics and search engine providers that assist us in the improvement and optimisation of our site.

Where we store your data

The data that we collect from will may be transferred to, and stored at, our secure servers within the European Economic Area (EEA). However, from time to time, your personal data may be transferred to, stored in or access from a destination outside the EEA. It may also be processed by staff operating outside the EEA who work for us or for one of our suppliers. Such staff may be engaged in, among other things, the fulfilment of your order, the processing of your payment details and the provision of support services. By submitting your personal data, you agree to this transfer, storing or processing. Where this is the case, we will ensure that any transfer of your data is adequately protected in compliance with data protection law.

All information you provide to us is stored on our secure servers. Any payment transactions will be encrypted [using SSL technology]. How long we keep your personal data

How long we hold your personal data for will vary. The retention period will be determined by various criteria including the purpose for which we are using it and any legal obligations attached to the retention of your personal data. If you are a customer, our policy is to keep all

personal data for a period of 10 years following the termination of any client relationship. If you request us to delete your personal data at any time during our relationship, we will do so to the extent we are capable under law.

Your rights

Under GDPR you have the following rights:

- To obtain access to, and copies of, the Personal Data that we hold about you
- To require that we cease processing your personal data if the processing is causing you damage or distress
- To require us not to send you marketing communications
- To require us to erase your Personal Data
- To require us to restrict our data processing activities
- To require us to correct the Personal Data we hold about you if it is incorrect or incomplete
- To lodge a complaint with the Information Commissioner's Office should you feel we are misusing your Personal Data
